CLASS 2 A DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVE

OPEN

An Exhibit without the use of floral foam

Space Allowed: Width 80cm, Depth 70cm, Height 106cm.

CLASS 3 MURMURS OF A SUMMER'S DAY

OPEN

An Exhibit to feature garden plant material

Space Allowed: Width 80cm, Depth 70cm, Height 106cm.

CLASS 4 IN CLASSIC STYLE

OPEN

An Exhibit

Space Allowed: Width 80cm, Depth 70cm, Height 106cm.

CLASS 5 SUNBURST

OPEN

An Exhibit

Space Allowed: Width 80cm, Depth 70cm, Height 106cm.

CLASS 6 PERFECTLY FORMED

OPEN

A Petite Exhibit

Space allowed: width 25cm, depth 25cm, height 37cm

REGULATIONS

1. Exhibits to be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual Third Edition 2015.
2. Judges: NAFAS National Judges Bríd Kelleher and Mary O'Brien
3. Novice – An exhibitor who has not won a first prize at a major show.
4. A Novice may also enter an Open Class.
5. Exhibits should be the original, unaided work of the competitor and not have been entered previously on any forum.
6. Competitors may enter as many classes as they wish but may not stage more than one entry per class.
7. By entering the competition, you are agreeing to allowing an image of your design be published and named by AOIFA & The Munster Agricultural Society, in any form.
8. The Judges' decision is final.
9. Online Entries will open from Monday 17th May 2021 to Friday 11th June 2021. On-line Entries Only – www.corksummershow.com

STAGING & RESULTS

Enter class by logging on to the **Cork Summer Show Website**. Select your class under **Floral Art** and attach a front view, high resolution photograph.

Only one photograph of your exhibit is required except in the case of a Pavé / Tapestry design, where an additional aerial photograph is required. A 30cm ruler is to be included in the front of the photograph of all exhibits except in the case of the Petite design, where it is required to include a €2 coin, instead.

- Each competitor's exhibit will be allocated a number and forwarded to the Judges.
- Results will be announced, and comments given on Sat. 19th June. (We will keep the AOIFA social media updated.)
- Entry €5 per Entry
- Electronic Certificates will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prize winners and to the winner of Best in Show.

CLASS 1 – 5 A photograph of the plant entry growing in your garden or in a pot.

- CLASS 1 A HYBRID TEA ROSE
- CLASS 2. A FLORIBUNDA ROSE
- CLASS 3. A FLOWERING SHRUB
- CLASS 4. A HOSTA
- CLASS 5. A VARIEGATED SHRUB

Class 6 - 7 A photograph of your entry in a container i.e. a Vase or Jar.

- CLASS 6. 3 STEMS PERENNIAL GARDEN FLOWERS – DIFFERENT VARIETIES.
- CLASS 7. 3 STEMS OF IVY – DIFFERENT VARIETIES

Class 8 to 10 A 30cm ruler is to be included in the photograph.

- CLASS 8. INDOOR FLOWERING PLANT – POT NOT EXCEED 23CM
- CLASS 9. A CACTUS – POT NOT EXCEED 15 CM
- CLASS 10. A WINDOW BOX NOT TO EXCEED 75CM IN LENGTH

Children's Class (U16)

- CLASS 11 A Miniature Garden (on a biscuit tin lid or similar sized base)
- CLASS 12 Collection of Wildflowers Arranged in A Jar/Vase.
